Keeping in touch

We appreciate that communication is very different when your child starts secondary school and we apologise for any teething problems in the first few weeks while all new students' details are added to our systems.

We will be reducing the amount of paper which comes home for school letters and reports. We know from parental and student feedback that letters are not always the most effective way to share information and we will therefore be focusing on the following methods of communication:



GO 4 Schools is an online school data system which gives parents and students quick access to timetables, attendance data, behaviour, progress and reports. A user guide can be found on the school website.



Satchel One is the online homework platform used at King Edward VI School to allow students, parents, and carers to view homework tasks and other bits of information that have been set by members of staff. The Satchel One website and app can be accessed using either a home PC, tablet PC or smartphone.



Microsoft Office 365 is a secure Internet-based communication and collaboration tool hosted by Microsoft to facilitate learning. It allows students to access apps like Word, PowerPoint, OneDrive and Teams from any web browser using most internet-enabled devices. Students are not required to purchase Office 365 at home to access the system as their accounts fall under the school's Microsoft site license that is currently in place. Students are regularly reminded that their school accounts should only be used for academic purposes.

ParentPay used for Educational Visits and payment for school meals to support our cashless catering system in school. You can also use it to view the meal choices your child has made.



Groupcall is a home/school communication platform.
