A LEVEL BIOLOGY BRIDGING TASK

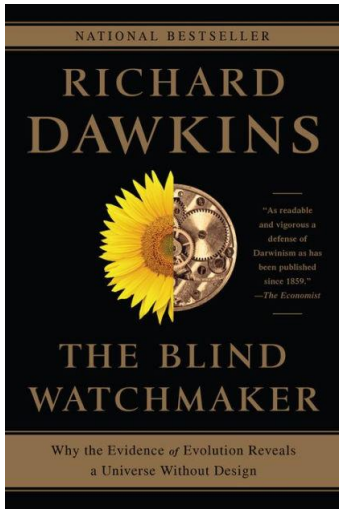
As part of your preparation for A Level Biology, we want to know more about you and your interests in Science.
